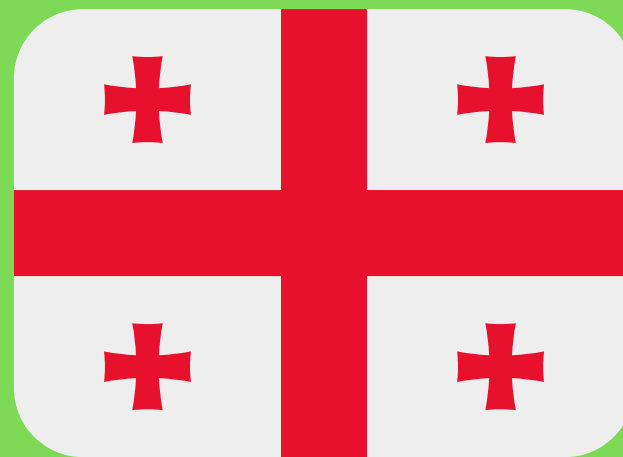

WHAT IS THE ENVIRONER PROJECT?

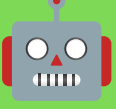
The Vision: Bridging digital tech, systems thinking, and environmental education to empower the next generation of youth workers across Europe.

Practicalities



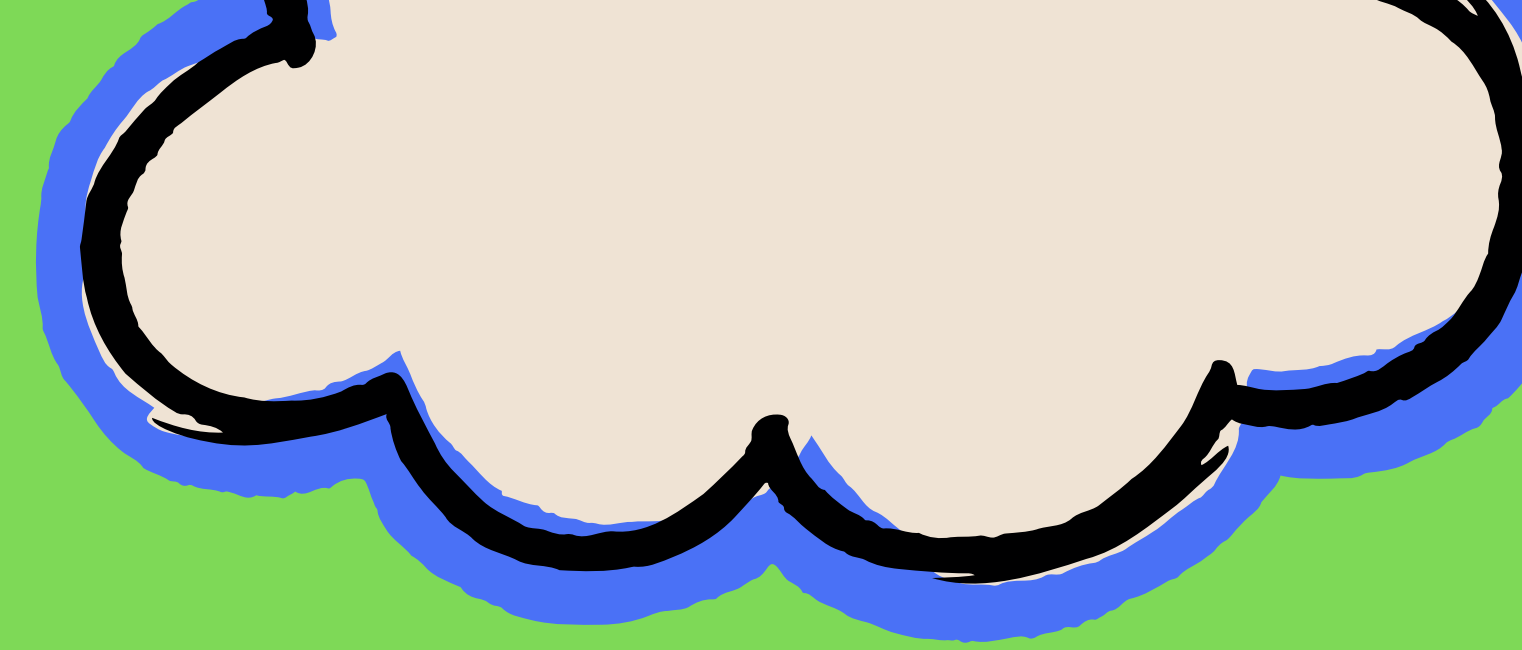
Certification: All participants will receive an official Youthpass Certificate highlighting key competencies gained.
